Investing with the Seabee Memorial Scholarship Association (SMSA) builds America's future. The association receives between 200-250 applications annually, but due to limited resources, SMSA can fund less than 10% - approximately 20-25 new scholarships each year.

Ways to Honor Seabee Service

Honor the service of America's fighting Seabees and support the higher education dreams of a deserving student with your gift to SMSA. There are many ways you can support SMSA scholarship recipients.

1. Establish a Term-Limited Scholarship
An investment of \$20,000 provides four,
one-year, named scholarships to deserving scholars.

2. Give in Memory or Honor of a Seabee There is no more meaningful way to recognize someone significant to you than by investing in educational opportunities for future generations in their name.

3. Create a Perpetual Named Scholarship

An Investment of \$60,000 for a shared named scholarship or \$120,000 for an individual named scholarship in honor or memory of an individual or corporation.

4. Make a Planned Gift
